

# Academy Trophy (AT) Rules 2021

(Version 1.2021)

## 1. Overview

- 1.1. The Goal of AT is a permanent Challenge in Hike&Fly in Switzerland.
- 1.2. The AT is organized by the X-alps Academy – local Athletes.
- 1.3. The Race Committee consists of: Chrigel Maurer, Bernhard Senn, Thomas Kalbermatter, Andreas Beieler, Fabian Umbricht, Sebastian Weber
- 1.4. The Race Committee aims to increase reputation of the hike&fly sport in your Region using your own Race as a part of a whole.
- 1.5. The FixFinder app is used to time the routes from the AT
- 1.6. The ranking is elaborated by fixfinder.ch and will be published also on <https://xalpsacademy.com/trophy/>
- 1.7. The race committee makes all decisions regarding the organisation and running of the AT.
- 1.8. The X-alps Academy is using the AT annual ranking for team selections.

## 2. Conditions of Participation

- 2.1. All athletes having to download the FixFinder App and signed in to participate.
- 2.2. All athletes can participate in the AT, but at their own risk.
- 2.3. To participate, the turnpoints must be scanned according to the Fixfinder App.
- 2.4. To participate, the athlete may only walk on public paths and roads.
- 2.5. The route must be able to be assigned a track (GPS IGC / GPX from watch, smartphone).
- 2.6. The tracks of the best 3 of the categories will be checked for validity!

## 3. Race Schedule

- 3.1. The AT start each year March 1. and ends with the price giving in autumn.

- 3.2. The Price Giving of the AT will be on a pre-announced day in autumn of each year, the details will be published on the website <https://xalpsacademy.com/trophy/>

## 4. General Conditions

- 4.1. The Academy does not organise competitions – it only consists of an overall ranking and a price giving.
- 4.2. The athlete flies at his own responsibility
- 4.3. The athlete behaves in an exemplary manner and flies only in appropriate circumstances
- 4.4. The equipment can be freely chosen
- 4.5. The minimum equipment consists of a certified paraglider, harness with protector or airbag, rescue parachute and helmet.

## 5. Ranking and Awards

- 5.1. The AT honours the fastest ladies and gentlemen
- each Fit Check (every location and route)
  - each XC Check (every location and route)
  - overall Fit Check (all locations and routes in total)
  - overall XC Check (all locations and routes in total)
